Opioid Response Plans

- HOPE Council Statewide focus on laws, policy & Medicaid funding.
- Community-wide Response to the Opioid Epidemic" CAHS/BH collaborative
 - □ Cross-sector, nine focus areas.
- BR Health District Opioid Taskforce
 - □ Opioid Taskforce focused on hospital based prescribing practices. Note: BCBS/Medicaid saw decreases in fast acting scripts by 28%. Also provider, patient and family training/education, prevention of NAS and advocating for increased EB treatment.

 - □ Prevention/Referral & Expansion of MAT
 - □ Narcan Distribution (2k)/Grief Counseling Groups/ Recovery Supports
- La State Opioid Response Program (La SOR)
 - □ Media/Prevention: Generation Rx/Rx Take Back
 - □ Mobile Outreach/Scat Teams/Narcan Distribution
 - □ Expanded MAT in Community and Prisons
 - ☐ Tx for Opioid Addicted Preg. Women and their Children Case Mgt. and Recovery House
 - On-line physician consultations by Tulane

Opioid Prevention, Treatment & Services

- OPAL: Opioid Prevention Alliance for Ladies & Girls - CAHS (OWH/DHHS)
 - □ Education, Training, Media Campaign
 - □ Medication Take-back: "Be a Hero"
- GRACE: Guiding Recovery & Creating Empowerment for Pregnant Women w/Opioid Use Disorder - Woman's Hospital (United Health Foundation)
 - □ Care coordination to opioid addicted expectant mothers & after delivery

Child Focused BH Services

- Parent Child Interactive Training (PCIT)
 Implemented at CAHS (United HC)
 - □ Professional training and certification in EBP for young children. Monitors/mentors parents
- Positive Parenting Program (Triple P)
 - □ Equips parents with skills to be able to manage family problems. Builds on positive relationships.
- Child-Parent Psychotherapy (CPP), Addressing the Child's Trauma Response.
 - □ Supports and strengthen the relationship of the child (0-5) and care giver.

Child Focused BH Services

- Transformational Transfer Initiative (TTI) -LDH/OBH/OCDD/HHS SAMHSA
 - □ Professional training, mentoring and certification. Increased access for children w/Intellectual Dis./SED
- Strategic Prevention Framework SAMHSA/ CAHS
 - □ Focus on underage drinking in West Feliciana.
- CAHS School Based BH Svs 44 Schools
 - □ Continues to expand as invited

Integrating BH and Primary Care

- CAHS/OHCC (SAMHSA)
 - □ Provide integrated services w/in largest MH/ARS Clinic, establish medical home.

- BCBS Quality Blue Initiative: CAHS & BR Clinic
 - □ Implement BH svs in largest multi-specialty clinic as pilot for statewide model.
- CAHS/OHCC Co-location, North Baton Rouge
 - □ MDMHC, CAHS to move to Howell Place

Adult BH Crisis Services

- AOT Law Update
 - □ Regional panel of providers established. CAHS has key responsibility and oversight. Note: OPC increased by 120 since 2016.
- CIT Training CAHS
 - □ Provides free of Charge (3) 40 hr institutes/year. All BRPD Cadets now being trained. Police/Sheriff/P&P
- Bridge Center
 - □ Tax passed, CEA approved, SOP being completed.
 - \square Board to release SOP shortly.

Adult BH Crisis Services

- My Choice (LDH/OBH/DOJ)
 - □ Voluntary de-institutionalization of adults (4k) w/SMI residing in NH through self-determination and choice. Note: over 225 assessed, 65 transitioning, 24 completed.
 - Initiative includes the development of a statewide crisis continuum; OBH letting an RFI on system proposals in a few weeks.

- Justice Involved Services
 Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Program: COAP (OBH/ CAHS (DOC)) - In EBRPP to improve post-release and rentry continuity of care and decrease OD and deaths.
 - □ Opioid focused BH assessment & d/c planning
 - □ Peer Support Seeking Safety (EBP) groups & reentry case management
- DOC/CAHS (LaSOR) Pre-release & rentry case management, initiate Vivitrol or other.
- Bridge Center, Pre-trial McArthur Grant (EBRPP)
 - ☐ For non-violent offenders who present to the prison with mental health and/or substance abuse issues.

- Justice Involved Services
 Pre-/Post- Release Fed. Offenders CAHS/BOP
 - □ Provide MH, ARS and Co-occurring Tx, working closely with P & P. Note: 177 clients in 5 months.
- Justice Reinvestment (DOC)/La-Pri Region 2
 - ☐ Gov and NGO providers planning and grant making for Reg 2, focused on full array of rentry services.
- SAMHSA La Planning Initiative/BR and NOLA
- Statewide Crisis Continuum Development-LDH/OBH/DOJ-My Choice Initiative.

Outcomes Measures and EBP Implementation

- Shatter Proof OBH, Statewide Initiative
 - □ Establish outcomes measures for all Medicaid funded addiction treatment services.
- Center for Evidence to Practice Statewide Initiative, OBH/ Medicaid, (LSUHSC-School of Public Health)
 - □ Identify and provide TA to implement more EBP for children and youth, provide support to maintain fidelity in treatment and to address sustainability.
